Exhibit Rules

To avoid confusion on Show Day, please get your exhibit entry fees and forms to: 4 Belvedere Road, Highweek, by **9pm on Thursday 14th July.**

1. All exhibits in the adult classes must have been either raised, grown or made by a competitor.
2. Any purchased pot plants must have been obtained at least 3 months prior to the show.
3. Children's classes are open to all children. Entries must be their own unaided efforts during the last 12 months.

4. Entries will be accepted on Saturday 16th July between 8.30am and 10am at the Highweek Village Hall.
5. No competitor shall win more than one award in any class.
6. Points awarded will be 1st 3 points, 2nd 2 points, 3rd 1 point.
7. Judging will start at 10.30am and the judges decision is final.
8. Entries submitted will be auctioned at the end of the show.
9. Those items **not** for auction should be marked '**Not for Sale**'.
10. Please do not remove entries from the display before 4pm.

All competitors must leave the hall before the start of judging.

Bake in a lined round 6" tin for 1½ hours. Gas Mark 4, 180°C, middle shelf.

Method: Creaming method.

Ingredients:

225g (8oz) Self raising flour

115g (4oz) Butter or margarine

¼ tsp salt

115g (4oz) Caster sugar

225g (9oz) Mixed fruit

2 eggs

100ml milk

Grated orange and lemon rind
